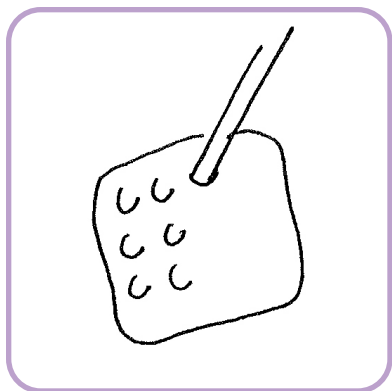
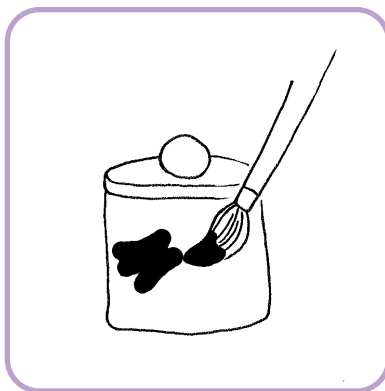


# Decorating



While the clay is wet, use a needle tool (or skewer) to carve designs.



Use a paint brush to add underglaze or glaze to your project.



After underglaze is dry, you can scratch into the colors to make patterns that show the clay underneath. This is called sgraffito. Sgraffito comes from an Italian word meaning “to scratch.”



Use coils to add letters, numbers, or shapes. Don't forget to scratch and attach!
